### WORKPLACE PROTECTIONS

**SB701** would have extended workplace protections to LGBT state employees. Senators received marks for voting in favor of the legislation. While the bill did not make it to the House floor, Delegates received a positive ranking for their copatronage of SB701. **BILL FAILED**

### BULLYING POLICIES

**HB1871** clearly establishes guidelines and model policies for codes of student conduct to aid school boards in implementation of such policies. While the bill does not include enumeration for sexual orientation or gender identity, EVA sees this as the starting point to protecting youth across the state. **BILL PASSED**

### DISCRIMINATION IN PUBLIC UNIVERSITY STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS

**HB1617** and companion **SB1074** requires public universities to fund and recognize student groups that choose to discriminate in their membership based on religious or political beliefs. It offers no protection for the students subject to discrimination. *Legislators received positive marks for voting against this bill.* **BILLS PASSED**

### TRACY THORNE-BEGLAND

In 2012, Virginia made national headlines when qualified judicial nominee Tracy Thorne-Begland did not receive confirmation from the House to serve as a judge because he is an out gay man. This year, HR126 and SR27 confirmed Thorne-Begland to the bench, and legislators received positive marks from EVA for voting yes. **RESOLUTIONS PASSED**
